This week's Bitesize lessons are all about poetry. Follow the activities through.

- On Monday you will be asked to write a poem about the night. I wondered if you could use the same method to write a poem about the sea. You might need to have a walk down to the beach. Think about what you can hear, see and smell.
- On Tuesday you will be learning about onomatopoeia. I wonder if you can write a sound poem about the things you might hear at the sea side.

The lessons differ between Y3 and 4 for the rest of the week but I would be delighted to see any poems you have written about our topic based around the following lessons.

Other ideas: Have a look on Pobble365 (<https://www.pobble365.com/>) if your child enjoys writing stories. There is a story idea every day. Perhaps you could include some onomatopoeia or some similes and metaphor which were covered a few weeks ago.
